

Students can access our free, confidential services if:

- They are enrolled in a college in Mercer County
- They have experienced a crime or traumatic event.

Note: The crime or traumatic event does not need to be recent or reported for the student to be eligible. Concerned friends and loved ones are also eligible for services.

What We Offer:

- Medical assessment and referral
- Assistance with understanding all support and reporting options available
- Post-medical follow up
- Individual and group counseling for the student and loved ones
- Transportation and accompaniment to the local emergency room
- Peer2Peer support groups and racial trauma workshops.
- Available to respond and help with traumatic crisis events on campus

Students can choose to receive any or all of these services based on individual needs.
